

ENTRY

We encourage players and teams to pre-register before Oktoberfest. You may also register at Oktoberfest on Saturday, September 21st. The entry fee is \$10 per team.

TOURNAMENT

The tournament will consist of two heats – each consisting of a mini-tournament. You may choose which heat you want to participate in until that Heat is full. The top 2 teams from each heat will compete in the Championship Round.

- Practice Time: 12-12:30pm
- Heat A runs from 12:30-3:45pm.
- Heat B runs 3:45-7pm.
- Championship Round: 7:15pm

PRIZES

Each heat will have the opportunity to win a package of Oktoberfest and brewery swag. The team with the most wins during the heat will receive a trophy.

LOCATION

The game will be played inside the Edmonds Oktoberfest at the Frances Anderson Field (700 Main Street, Edmonds, WA 98020)

EQUIPMENT

Two balls (volley) and 12 buckets. All equipment is provided.

NUMBER OF COURTS

There is only one court for the event. Teams can enjoy music and other festivities between games.

SIGN-UP

Teams can register online through EdmondsOktoberfest.com. Teams can also sign up the day of the event (pending open slots).

TRACKING WINS

The tournament staff will track wins for teams. At the end of each heat, a winner will be declared. The number of rounds played will depend on the number of teams entered for each heat.

HOW TO PLAY

Court: Below is a diagram of the court. Court will be 24 feet from the outer edge of the back row of buckets.



Teams: Teams consist of 2 players. Teammates play on the same side of the court. Each member of the team must throw one of the balls on their turn.

Throw Zone: All throws by a team must be made from behind their buckets.

Start of Game: Initial possession is determined by: rock-paper-scissors.

Play: Each team takes turns throwing two balls per turn. Teams try to land the ball in the other team's buckets. When a ball goes into a bucket, then the bucket is removed.

Re-Racks: Buckets will be re-racked as buckets are removed and there are four or less buckets. See re-rack formation below.



End of Game: As soon as one team eliminates all the other team's buckets, or the team with the most buckets left at the end of the 10-minute time limit.

Time Limit: Each game will have a 10-minute time limit. The time limit will start when the first ball is thrown. The tournament director may elect to start the clock early if a team is delaying the start of the game.

Beer Drinking: There is no requirement to drink a beer after your bucket is removed, but you are more than welcome to. ***Please drink responsibly.***
